Who can access ODEEP services?

Infants, preschoolers, school aged children and their families. The children may have a diagnosed disability or may have difficulty learning to play, move, talk, learn and socialise.

What do we do?

- We support children with developmental delays and disabilities to have access to the same opportunities as other children their age.
- We work in partnership with families and other professionals to support the inclusion of children in their community.
- We provide one on one therapy, positive behaviour support, special education, family support and a dietitian.
- We provide support for daily living skills, participating in the community, feeling included in mainstream activities and transitioning into new phases of life such as daycare, preschool or school.
- Services are family-centred and are tailored to meet each family's needs.

How do you access us?

We take self referral from families or referrals from:

- Doctors
- Paediatricians
- Therapists
- Early Childhood Services
- · Other agencies such as Community Health

Referrals are accepted provided permission has been obtained from the child's parent/carer.
